- "Smart Villages are communities in rural areas that use *innovative* solutions to improve their resilience, building on local strengths and opportunities.
- They rely on a *participatory approach* to develop and implement their strategy to improve their economic, social and/or environmental conditions, in particular by mobilizing solutions offered by *digital technologies*.
- "The use of digital technologies is not a precondition for becoming a Smart Villages".

Smart Villages – ENRD TG Messages

No one model Digital <u>and</u> social.

Fast and flexible support for community led innovative action – not words





What could a Smart Village look like in terms of mobility?


Shared mobility	Conventional public transport

Smart Villages in Finland



Smart Village cooperation projects	Local village level – at least 2 villages – fast and flexible support for the implementation of innovative actions that respond to a specific local challenge or need
Smart Village Activation Projects	Subregional level or regional or- groups of villages cooperating together on common issues that require larger scales
Network of Innovation Brokers	Network of Smart Villages Innovation Brokers covering fields such as digital technologies, energy, mobility, service innovations and so on.
Simplified Costs	A menu of Simplified Cost Options including lump sums with draft budgets





Ideas for supporting Smart Villages

Smart Villages in Poland



Preparatory Support	Local village level – at least 2 villages – preparation of Smart Villages concepts or plans/strategies - Art.71 Cooperation & LEADER
Implementation of Smart Villages plan	Implementation of the SV concepts/plans and help to draw resources from other dedicated support interventions (investments) - Art.71 Cooperation & LEADER; Art.68 Investment
Network of Innovation Brokers	Advisory services, LAGs and National Rural Networks (NRNs), support preparation of SV plans, animation and providing links to specialised providers of knowledge
Simplified Costs	A menu of Simplified Cost Options including lump sums


